Allen Milam, 89 of Corinth is set for Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 2:00pm at Magnolia Funeral Home Chapel of Memories with interment in Magnolia Gardens. Milam left this walk of life from the MS State Veteran Home in Oxford to go to his heavenly home on Friday, September 6, 2019. He was a licensed minister with the United Pentecostal Church, Int. He was called to the ministry in 1948 and he touched many lives during the past 71 years. Before his death, he was the oldest living minister in the UPCI in the nation. Rev. Milam was a member of Zion Pentecostal Church and his mission was preaching and teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ. He served on active duty in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict.
